Uluslararası Deniz Ticaret Odası'ndan (International Chamber of Shipping-ICS) alınan 23.05.2024 tarihli Ek'te sunulan yazıda;

IMO Uluslararası Emniyet Yönetimi (ISM) Kodunun Uygulanmasına İlişkin ICS Kılavuzu'nun altıncı baskısının yayımlandığı bildirilmektedir.

Uluslararası Emniyet Yönetimi (ISM) Kodunun Uygulanmasına İlişkin ICS Kılavuzları, denizcilik şirketlerinin koda uymalarına yardımcı olmakla beraber karadaki görevliler (DPA'lar) ve mürettebat için etkili, kullanıcı dostu bir güvenlik yönetim sistemi (SMS) geliştirmek, uygulamak ve sürdürmek için pratik bir rehber niteliği taşımaktadır.
